

ACRYLIC PAINTING with Eithne Byrne

Via Zoom on May 3rd, 17th, 24th and 31st, at 7:30 PM

Eithne has been teaching for over twelve years at the Jewish Community Senior Centers, providing Art Enrichment Programs which encompass health, wellness and skill building in painting in various mediums: Acrylic, Watercolor and Pastels.

She also teaches Online classes including Pastel and Acrylic painting for the United Federation of Teachers of New York.

For these sessions she will demonstrate step-by -step instructions how to paint a beautiful painting with acrylic paint. She will teach drawing and color mixing techniques. No experience is necessary.

We will provide the brushes and two canvas boards and a plastic paint holder. The acrylic paints can be purchased at Jerry's Artarama. You only need 2 fluid ounces of red, yellow, blue, white, and black. "Liquitex Basics Arcylic Paint Set." A set of 6 colors is \$8.90. (Amazon has sets but they are more expensive there).

Keep two water jars on the table with you to keep the brushes damp and clean. Also keep paper towels with you and a pencil and/or stick of chalk to draw.

Let us know if you plan to attend and we will arrange to provide you with your canvasses and brushes. (If you will be on the zoom link from FLorida, you will have to purchase two canvas boards yourselves...the canvas boards should be 11x14 and have one flat brush and one round one.)
