The Lucille & Jay Chazanoff Sunrise Day Camp is a FREE camp that welcomes over 150 children from Staten Island, Brooklyn, Manhattan, and nearby New Jersey to its location on the campus of Staten Island Academy each summer for several weeks of swimming, sports, games, and other camp activities. Operated by the Joan & Alan Bernikow JCC of Staten Island, the mission of Sunrise is to bring back the joys of childhood to children with cancer and their siblings. This mission is accomplished through an inclusive summer day camp, year-round programs, and in-hospital recreational activities, all offered free of charge. The Sunrise Day Camp staff team includes a medical director, on-site nurses, and a dedicated camp staff specially trained to meet the unique needs of its campers, while also providing a fun and memorable summer.

This past summer I volunteered 10 community service hours at Sunrise Day Camp, as an assistant theater teacher, working with my mother, sister, and grandmother. Volunteering at Sunrise Day Camp was a privilege and a learning experience.
